The federal identification number of the USDA licensed breeder was not always recorded on the Information Statement.

The individual identification number for dogs acquired from USDA licensed breeders was not always recorded on the Information Statement.

Records of vaccinations and worming treatments given were sometimes recorded as "2 weeks, 4 weeks, and 6 weeks of age". The actual date of administration and the type of vaccine and/or worming treatment administered must be recorded on the Information Statement.

The license renewal application stated that 11 cats were sold in 2011. There were no Information Statements on file for any cats sold.
