Consumers are provided a copy of the NY State warranty known as the Sale of Dogs and Cats as well as a store handout titled "Pet World's Puppy Warranty". The store warranty guarantees against congenital defects until the animal is one year of age with a refund of $1 / 2$ the cost of the animal to treat the condition. This restricts the rights of the consumer under the Sale of Dogs and Cats for congenital defects found within 180 days of the date of purchase.

Medical conditions documented on three (3) Information Statements were not noted by the veterinarian on the animal's medical chart. Store personnel stated that these were conditions found by them during a visual check of the animal upon arrival at the store.

Section 6701 of Article 135 of NY State Education Law defines the practice of veterinary medicine as "diagnosing, treating, operating or prescribing for any animal disease, physical condition", etc. Only a person licensed or exempt under Article 135 shall practice veterinary medicine. Store employees are not exempt under the law. Any medical condition found by store personnel should be brought to the attention of the veterinarian. Verification of such conditions should be documented by the veterinarian on the medical chart as part of the health certification. These medical findings can then be documented on the Information Statement by the veterinarian or store personnel.
