Metronidazole is being used regularly was not listed in vet plan and Clavamox was being given to 2 puppies in Isolation and was not individually labeled. Signature log of veterinary visits at least every 12 months not available.

According to Article 26A, 401.5 (a) the veterinary plan must dictate how the pet dealer is to medically treat dogs/cats. Any prescription medications on site (used preventively) must be accounted for in the vet plan. Preventative medications may include but are not limited to: vaccines, deworming medications, and medications used for nebulizing. If there are any additional medications which are not included in the veterinary plan which are used to treat a specific illness, these must be clearly identified with a label from attending veterinarian and individual animal information. If there is any deviation from the plan it must be documented in writing from attending vet.

There must be a written signature log with dates showing a veterinarian has been at the facility at least once every 12 months.
