REMARKS:

According to Article 26A, 401.5 (a) the veterinary plan must dictate how the pet dealer is to medically treat dogs/cats. Any prescription medications on site (used preventatively) must be accounted for in the veterinary plan. Preventative medications include, but are not limited to: vaccines, deworming medication, and medications used for nebulizing. Any non-routine veterinary care requires written proof from attending veterinarian, including the use of over the counter medications not labeled for dogs or cats. Medications used to treat specific illnesses must be clearly identified with a label from the attending veterinarian and individual animal information. Any deviation from the veterinary plan must be documented in written form by the attending veterinarian. There must be a written signature log with dates showing a veterinarian has been to the facility at least once every 12 months.

According to Article 26A, Section 401.5(b), Article 35D, Section 753-A.2, and NY Public Health Law Article 21, Title 4 Rabies, all animals must be vaccinated for rabies by four months of age as required by state law.

According to Article 26A, Section 403.1, Renewal applications shall be submitted to the commissioner at least 30 days prior to the commencement of the next license year.
