1. Shelter is structurally sound

2. Housing area and equipment is sanitized regularly

Bird feces present on/in runs after cleaning. Rodent feces/urine present in multiple areas of shelter. Outdoor trash cans used for feces have lids, but lids are not used. Receptacle used to disinfect fecal scoopers unclean, strong odor. Dog feces present in multiple high traffic walkways of shelter. Gravel areas at the end of runs need to be cleaned/sanitized thoroughly to avoid buildup of feces, hair, and debris. Cleaning procedures do not prevent the transmission of contagious disease (ex: parvo).

3. Repairs are done when necessary

Indoor and outdoor DCO designated runs (4, 9, 10, 11, 25) in need of paint/sealing to maintain surfaces which can be cleaned and disinfected.

4. Dogs are handled safely

Lacking practices to ensure health/safety of healthy dogs in "normal" kennel area from quarantined/isolated dogs with contagious disease. uate space is available for all dogs

5. Adequate space is available for all dogs

6. Light is sufficient for observation

7. Ventilation is adequate

Strong odor of feces present in both indoor and outdoor kennel areas. Strong odor of rodent urine/feces present in food storage areas. The is adequate Yes

8. Drainage is adequate 9. Temperature extremes are avoided No fan/air conditioning provided for Great Pyrenees in heat/humidity.

10. Clean food and water is available and in ample amount

Evidence of rodents in food storage and food prep areas (ex: storage area, feeding cart, feeding dishes). Dog food/treats/bones visibly contaminated by rodents. Dog food/treats/bones not stored in a manner to prevent contamination by rodents or cleaning products or to prevent spoilage.
