## **REMARKS:**

Upon an unannounced inspection, the kennel area was found to have very dirty walls with numerous cobwebs surrounding the walls/ceilings. The area where the food/water dishes was also dirty/dusty. One dog was housed in the kennel. The cage was clean and there were two large piles of fresh feces in the cage. I spoke to Gary Hadsell via phone and he said he hadn't been to the kennel that morning yet because he was out on a dog call. He assured me that there were plans to clean/paint the interior of the kennel shortly.

The outdoor runs are not used. Evidently, the dogs are harassed by youngsters since there is no fence surrounding them. I have scheduled an appointment to review Mr. Hadsell's records next week.

I spoke with the town supervisor last week and he has assured me that the new kennel will be constructed within the next six months. There have been some concerns with the site by the village of Canisteo. Those issues have been worked out and construction is supposed to proceed. The shelter will be inspected every three months until which time the new shelter is up and running.
