All surfaces within the primary enclosure must be replaced or repaired when worn or damaged. Dirty, rough and absorbent materials protect microorganisms and are difficult to clean, disinfect and deodorize. There must be no openings where an animal can become entrapped. Housing must be constructed and arranged to allow easy removal of the dog without injury. Repair or replace damaged sections to prevent dogs from ingesting any materials that may come loose from chewing and clawing the enclosure. Any openings where dogs can escape must be closed. Rust needs to be removed and surfaces repaired to allow proper sanitation.
