| <i>In order for the stray dog housing area to be sanitized in its entirety, dog food and porous objects that are currently stored in kennels on one side of the area must be removed. If these materials have been exposed to infectious substances, they should not be returned to the sanitized area. Kennels on the other side of the area that are used to house dogs are sanitized regularly. Bags of dog food and other items left in the area during cleaning and sanitizing may absorb moisture and become contaminated. It is recommended that a separate storage area be utilized.</i> | |

Disposition and Seizure Report #11-85 documented that an unidentified shepherd mix dog hit by a car and seized at 9:30 pm on 6/7/11 was not immediately examined by a veterinarian. Barre Animal Hospital was not available that night and the dog was impounded at the shelter. The veterinarian was also not available the next day. The dog was taken to a veterinarian on 6/9/11 given pain medication as it was unable to use its hindquarters, and was returned to the shelter. The dog was found dead at the shelter the morning of 6/10/11.

Any seized dog suffering from illness or injury must receive prompt treatment by a licensed veterinarian. The dog must be maintained in a state of comfort. If recommended by the veterinarian in writing, an unidentified dog may be euthanized without delay to eliminate suffering.
