## **REMARKS:**

Kennel areas (wood, concrete, cracks in floor) unable to be completely cleaned and disinfected due to these materials being porous, unsealed. The temperature surrounding the animal must be conducive to its health and well-being. Dogs must be protected from temperature extremes. The ambient temperature should not fall below 45-50F for an animal not acclimated to lower temperatures, a breed that cannot tolerate lower temperatures without stress and discomfort (such as a short-haired breed), or a sick, aged, young, or infirm animal, except as approved by a licensed veterinarian. Auxiliary ventilation, such as fans, blowers, or air conditioning must be added to keep the animal cool in temperatures 85F and up.
