Framing of the guillotine doors within many of the kennels is corroded by rust that cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized (kennels #1-8 on the right side of the aisle, and kennels #1-3, 5 & 6 on the left side of the aisle). The concrete block wall of the exterior wall between kennels #5 & 6 on the right side has an area at floor level that is eroding away. The porous nature of unsealed concrete means this cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized. The frame of the exterior chainlink door of kennel #5 on the right side has pitted rust at floor level, and cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized.
