These are the findings of an inspection of your facility on the date(s) indicated above:

1. Shelter is structurally sound

No

In outdoor kennels, repairs needed on crumbling/missing concrete blocks. Dividing walls of several interior kennels not structurally sound. A few areas of wall have large enough holes for dogs to crawl through between kennels.

2. Housing area and equipment is sanitized regularly

No

Rusted/corroded pipes/chain link and unsealed concrete block walls are unable to be cleaned/sanitized properly. Buildup of feces & debris in troughs and covering/blocking openings of outdoor drains.

3. Repairs are done when necessary

No

In both interior and outdoor kennels, dividing walls and doors have rusted/corroded pipes with sharp edges exposed Chain walls/doors several excessively rusted/corroded. doas. link of kennels are Crumbling/cracked/missing concrete block in exterior runs. Missing/damaged tiles on walls of interior runs. One guillotine door is not properly seated in track, and the safety chain is not connected to the wall- the door is at risk of falling and causing injury. Several chain link panels on dividing walls and doors in need of repair. Gaps in chainlink doors could allow for potential escape and/or injury. 2nd play yard on the pond side of the building has multiple areas where dogs have previously dug under the chainlink fence that are now being barricaded by concrete blocks held with exposed rebar in the enclosure.

All enclosures housing seized dogs must be structurally sound and kept in good repair to keep the dog contained and to protect it from injury. There must be no rust, jagged edges or sharp points. All surfaces within the primary enclosure must be replaced or repaired when worn or damaged. Dirty, rough and absorbent materials (such as unsealed concrete) protect microorganisms and are difficult to clean, disinfect and deodorize. There must be no openings where an animal can become entrapped. Housing must be constructed and arranged to allow easy removal of the dog without injury. Any openings where dogs can escape must be closed.
