The shelter corrected the deficiencies noted in the last inspection. New wood panels were placed in each of the kennels that are used to house dogs. The kennels no longer pose a danger to the dogs that are housed in them. The ventilation is still less than adequate and it is recommended that an exhaust fan be installed. An old piece of furniture remains in the kennel that has no real purpose. It is recommended that this be removed. The DCO's were not able to meet me at the shelter so the inspection was unannounced and one of the highway workers (who used to be the DCO) had the key to the kennel and allowed me to inspect it. There was no paperwork to review at this time.
