**REMARKS:**

The town has set up four dog runs in a secured town building that was used for sign making. Some tools and equipment are still stored there. The pre-fab wire dog runs are set up in an area clear of these items. Wood 2x4's support metal siding that forms a solid barrier wall between the kennels. A guillotine pass door is cut into the wall to allow dogs to be moved from one kennel to another for cleaning or exercise purposes. Flooring consists of concrete with a rubber mat provided for comfort. Food and supplies are adequate and stored properly. Heat and ventilation is available to avoid temperature extremes.
