Although not in direct contact with any animals, a sealant is recommended as it would make the surfaces impervious which would allow for thorough sanitation and faster drying times.

Staff has prepared a work order request for the county building department to affect some repairs including:

Dog kennel #3 has exposed sharp metal edges along the upper sections of the guiding tracks that position the guillotine door.

Dog kennel #14 has some areas above the concrete block where the wall sheeting has been torn away and the surface beneath exposed.

Kennels needing repairs are not used to house animals.
