It was noted that the ventilation in the housing area for the dogs was somewhat less than adequate on the day of inspection. The air was a bit stagnant. However, it was a cold day and the windows/doors were closed so the air movement was less than desirable.

However, the shelter charged a "boarding fee" above and beyond the amount of the impoundment fee as stipulated by Article 7, Section 117, part 4. It was explained that this cannot be done unless the municipality has agreed to this in the contract or has enacted a local law to this effect. This was brought to the attention of the shelter manager and only the aforementioned impoundment (aka "redemption" fee) will be collected in the future.
