REMARKS:

No dogs have been in the kennel for the past six months. There has been no dog control activity since the last inspection. The dog door to the outside kennel in the middle kennel is torn and the molding is splintered. This should be repaired. This is a potential source of injury if a dog is housed in this run. The grass should be mowed around the outside kennel to keep pests to a minimum.

The door to the kennel has rust streaks and should be painted. There is a window in the kennel that was left open to facilitate air movement, but another exhaust vent would help to circulate the air. Inadequate ventilation could be a concern if there are dogs housed in the kennel, especially on a warm day. The kennels are constructed such that the window can be left open and the dogs would not be accessible if someone entered through the window to try to reclaim a dog.

It is important to maintain the structural integrity of the shelter so it remains usable for years to come.
