These are the findings of an inspection of your facility on the date(s) indicated above:

1. Shelter is structurally sound

There are two outside runs (kennels #1 and #5 from the east side) that have sharp metal protruding from the side wall adjacent to the dog door. These dog doors to these two outside runs are now closed until they are properly repaired.

2. Housing area and equipment is sanitized regularly

3. Repairs are done when necessary

The outside runs as described above need to be repaired as soon as possible. Repairs also need to be done on the outdoor runs in the areas where the underlying rusted metal is exposed.

4. Dogs are handled safely

All the runs were full at the time of our inspection. However, if runs are needed for incoming dogs, the smaller dogs are moved to holding cages in another room.

No euthanasias were done since the time of the last inspection.

The redemption period starts as "day 1" the day after the seizure. "Day 5" continues until midnight. It would therefore, be simpler to count out six days from the date of seizure to the date that the dog is "transferred" to the humane society on the seizure report.

One puppy was redeemed without being licensed. All seized dogs must be licensed prior to redemption regardless of the age. Dogs too young to receive a rabies vaccination must still be licensed as per Article 7. It is recommended that a follow-up call be made to be sure the puppy has received its rabies vaccination.

REMARKS:

Two outdoor runs need repairs before dogs can safely use them again. Repairs still need to be done on most of the other outdoor kennels that have metal exposed around the outdoor run doorways that were originally covered with plaster. These do not pose an imminent danger for the dogs, but needs to be addressed in the near future.

The paperwork is in good order. Please note that the redemption period is five days, starting with the day after the dog is seized. The paperwork now indicates the day the dog is transferred to the Hornell Humane Society, in response to our recommendation at our last visit. One puppy was redeemed before it was licensed.
