Repairs were made to the outdoor kennels that had the sharp edges of metal exposed. Some of the outdoor kennels still have chipped paint around the walls of the dog doors. This does not present a danger to dogs at this time, but it is recommended that this issue be addressed before it deteriorates further.

REMARKS:

Twenty-five dogs were brought in as municipal dogs since the last inspection. The necessary repairs were made to the outside kennels as described in the previous inspection. There are still areas where the paint is chipped on the outside runs around the dog doors. This does not present a danger to the dogs at this time, but it is recommended that this be addressed so this structural issue does not deteriorate over time.

Two dogs were redeemed without getting a license. One of these was a puppy that was too young to get a rabies vaccination. All redeemed dogs need to be licensed even if they are too young to get a rabies vaccination. This was also discussed at the time of the last inspection (see earlier report).

There is a new contract with the city of Hornell. This was not available for at the time of the inspection. It is currently being revised and has not been finalized, as per my discussion with the shelter employees.
