REMARKS:

Regarding the redemption of dogs:

- Dogs seized by DCOs are redeemed upon proof of payment of an impoundment fee to the proper municipality.
- For dogs brought to the shelter by Good Samaritans and subsequently claimed by an owner, no proof of payment to the municipality is required as these dogs are considered by the shelter to have been seized under Article 26 of NY State Agriculture and Markets Law.
- The shelter may charge the owner a fee to cover the cost of holding the dog. This is allowed under Section 374.7 of Article 26 which states "the owner of the animal may redeem the same upon proving title to the satisfaction of such society and paying such society such amount, approved by a magistrate, as may have been reasonably expended by such society in connection with the care and maintenance thereof".

Regarding the licensing of dogs:

- In the case of Good Samaritan dogs, it has been determined that "proving title to a dog" as required in Section 374.7 of Article 26 may be in a form other than a license. For unlicensed dogs, the shelter may collect a license fee which is sent with an application to the proper municipality but has not been done in all cases.

Regarding impoundment fees:

- The inspector made contact with some town clerks in order to clarify the collection of impoundment fees as pertains to Article 7 or to their local code.
