## **REMARKS:**

Dave Phillips and I did an unannounced inspection of the shelter on 1/2/14. There were no dogs in the shelter at the time of inspection on. A food bowl was full in an empty cage. There were some items left on the floor. General housekeeping needs to be improved. I met with Gary Hadsell on 1/4/14.

It is recommended that the rusted kennels be replaced or re-finished. The upper parts of the walls need to be finished so the insulation is not exposed inside the kennel. Ventilation was adequate at the time of the inspection, but may prove to be a challenge in the warmer months or when the shelter houses numerous dogs. Consideration should be given to installing a large exhaust fan at some future date. The drain from the sink allows water to run downhill to the drainage area. Consideration should be given to install a means for the water to drain directly into the drainage area.
