One outdoor exercise yard (currently in use) has areas where the chain link is loose or broken. This area has been temporarily patched but needs further permanent repair. Five outdoor runs chain-link doors have holes or sharp wire that needs repair. One indoor run, the dog has removed the impervious surface exposing bare wood. While not a safety issue this area cannot be sufficiently disinfected. One 'meet & greet' room has been used to house various special needs dogs who have chewed the wood door casings. These should be replaced with impervious material that can be disinfected if this area is to be used to house dogs in the future. Also, recommend the door to the 'meet & greet room' which is bare wood be sealed or painted to allow for repeated cleaning and disinfecting.
