REMARKS:

The kennels are completely full. Temporary cages are used to house some of the dogs in side storage rooms. There does not appear to be any space to house additional dogs that may be brought in by the DCOs at this time.

There is an alcove that houses a litter of puppies. This is adjacent to a bank of cages used for temporary cat housing.

It should be noted that overcrowding in a shelter could possibly result in an infectious disease outbreak. Overcrowding increases stress, which, in turn, can reduce immune levels in the individual animals.

Some of the edges of the dog doors on the outside runs have paint/plaster that is peeling. There are no sharp edges evident at this time, but this structural issue should be addressed sometime in the near future.
