These are the findings of an inspection of your facility on the date(s) indicated above:

There are various areas around the shelter which need to be repaired. These include some of the walls where the drywall is exposed, some wood surfaces (especially around doorways) that have splintered wood exposed and the outdoor runs around the dog doors still have areas where the underlying metal is exposed. None of these present a danger to the dogs, but the structural soundness of the shelter could be compromised in the future.

4. Dogs are handled safely Yes

5. Adequate space is available for all dogs

All of the runs are full. There are two temporary cages in the hallway, of which one is empty.

Fans are running in the kennel and the side doors are open. Yet, there is a strong "doggy odor" evident upon entrance to the dog run area. There were many flies in the dog run area as well.

## **REMARKS:**

The shelter is in compliance with our minimum standards. It is strongly recommended that the structural soundness be maintained and repairs made as specifically listed in the report.

The main entrance into the building was noticed to be clean, neat and well-organized.

Although there is technically room for the admittance of more dogs, there was only one small cage that was available for additional municipal dogs that may be brought in. Two large fans were running in the kennel area. This helped with the ventilation but there was still a stronger than desired "doggy odor" in this room. The end doors were left open which allowed a large number of flies to enter the kennel area.
