**The main entrance into the building was noticed to be clean, neat and well-organized.**

**Although there is technically room for the admittance of more dogs, there was only one small cage that was available for additional municipal dogs that may be brought in. Two large fans were running in the kennel area. This helped with the ventilation but there was still a stronger than desired "doggy odor" in this room. The end doors were left open which allowed a large number of flies to enter the kennel area.**
