Kennels in need of resealing. Some runs have no sealant at all; not impermeable to cleaning solvents.

At the time of inspection; one dog lunged and snapped at Inspector Volpe. Concern of proper restraint methods.

Another dog was in an exercise yard off leash with a potential family and dog knocked 2 year old child into kiddy pool full of water. Gentleman commented when passing inspector that dog attacked child. Concern of good observation/handling methods.

One of 2 small dogs being housed in accessory building undergoing treatment for ringworm. This dog is crated in a room with cats that have free roam of the room. The shelter manager informed the inspector that the dog had been there 2 weeks and had starting showing signs of ringworm 2 days prior. Concern of no area to isolate dog to prevent spread of disease.
