## **REMARKS:**

TITLE: DCO

A number of dogs were surrendered to the shelter. It was discussed that accepting dogs from residents of towns that do not have a contract with the municipality for such services is acting as a pet dealer per Article 26-A of NY State Agriculture and Markets Law. DCO Maynard said that the shelter has no longer accepted dogs from such residents or from rescues since October 22, 2014 when informed of the Pet Dealer Law by an Agriculture and Markets representative. Currently, there is one rescue, located in the Town of Hamlin that houses and adopts out dogs at the shelter.

DCO Maynard said that the formation of an incorporated group to assist at the shelter is in development which would allow for an exemption to Pet Dealer Law as provided for in Section 400.4 of Article 26-A.
