New guillotine doors for 3 dog runs have not yet been installed.

Plywood walls in the outer kenneling area have lost some sealant properties and may absorb liquids. A new application of sealant would improve the resistance to liquids which allows for more thorough sanitation and faster drying times. Walls are not in direct contact with animals.

REMARKS:

A total of 380 dogs were handled by the shelter. The DCOs have oversight of the care and disposition of the animals in the shelter.

THE FOLLOWING DOGS WERE REDEEMED WITHOUT FOLLOWING THE REQUIREMENTS AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 117.4 OF ARTICLE 7:

- D052 - no record of payment of an impoundment fee was on file. (It was noted that release without payment was ordered by the Batavia Police.)
- D053 - no record of payment of an impoundment fee was on file. (It was noted that release without payment was ordered by the Batavia Police.)
- D122 - the dog was redeemed on 5/7/14 but payment of the impound fee was dated 12/12/14.
- D170 - no record of payment of an impoundment fee was on file.
- D173 - no license number or record of payment of an impoundment fee was on file.
- D227 - no record of payment of an impoundment fee was on file.
- D266 - no license number was on file (too young for a rabies vaccine).
- D360 - no license number or record of payment of an impoundment fee was on file.

Per the DCO, dogs were released without proof of payment of an impoundment fee due to the unavailability of the town clerk.

D266, a puppy, was released without a dog license because it was too young to be vaccinated for rabies and the town clerk said that the computer program does not allow a license to be processed without rabies vaccination information.

It was discussed that all dogs must be licensed prior to redemption regardless of what county the owner resides in. Dogs should be licensed in the municipality where the dog is to be harbored.

SECTION 117.4 OF ARTICLE 7 REQUIRES PAYMENT OF AN IMPOUNDMENT FEE AND THE DOG TO BE LICENSED PRIOR TO REDEMPTION.
