Be sure the dog doors are flush with the openings to the outdoor pens. Cold air could come in the doors. Heat lamps are in place however. The outermost cage wire on the end pen is pulled out in spots on the bottom. A sturdier gauge wire should be used when it is replaced in the future.

It is recommended that the kennel be maintained such that it does not deteriorate over time. The inside kennels should be kept such that the dog doors are solidly in place when there are no dogs in the kennel. It is suggested that a wood or steel door be placed at the dog door openings when not in use to keep cold air/snow from getting in. The outside kennel fencing on one side is not very sturdy and it is recommended that it be replaced with heavier gauge wire. The kennel should be swept clean on a regular basis and some rodent control be put in place as well. It is also recommended that the far wall be closed off so snow does not enter that end of the kennel through the roof.
