REMARKS:

Village of Albion DCO Harry Papponetti was also present for part of the inspection.

Orleans County ACO Kathy Smith supervises the shelter and handles redemptions of dogs and collection of impoundment fees in most cases. For dogs seized in the Village of Albion, the Village DCO handles almost all of those redemptions. Albion charges an impoundment fee separate from that of the shelter and a record of that payment is on file with the Village DCO. Documentation of that Village fee is not always recorded in the shelter records. Shelter records should accurately reflect those made and maintained by the DCO.

Contracts have been established with each town in the county. As a village lies within a town, contract language should be reviewed by a municipal attorney as to whether the villages of Albion, Holley and Medina are included in these contracts. If determined by the attorney that they are not, then a separate contract with each village should be established.

It was discussed with ACO Smith and DCO Papponetti that sick or injured dogs must be provided with prompt and appropriate medical care as directed by a veterinarian. Such care may be limited to making the dog comfortable and without physical suffering. It is not acceptable to deliver a dog in need of veterinary care to a shelter and leave it in a cage when no arrangements have been made for treatment. Clarification of responsibilities for veterinary care can be addressed in shelter contracts.
