These are the findings of an inspection of your facility on the date(s) indicated above:

1. Shelter is structurally sound

Per Article 7, Part 77.1(a), 77.2, several areas of the shelter are not structurally sound and sufficient to protect the dog contained therein from detriment to its well-being. In the DCO intake area; straps hanging down into enclosure from carriers stored above. These straps would be within reach of the dog housed within. The outside portion of this run marked 'Beware of dog' does not have a complete covering over the top and could permit a dog to climb out. In the main kennel there are two runs in the outside portion of the kennel, where the door wire (chain link) is not attached at the bottom. One run has a large opening in the concrete where a foot or toe could become lodged. There is a freestanding wire exercise pen in the yard at the back of the kennel that contains objects (pieces of bungees, and bungees with plastic balls attached) that dogs could ingest as well as a tarp that is caving into the run. On the inside of the main kennel, run #17 has a large hole in the door wire approximately 3' up the door where a dogs head could become lodged.

2. Housing area and equipment is sanitized regularly

The outdoor exercise enclosure in the yard behind the main kennel contained several piles of feces that needs to be removed. The large crack in the concrete in the outdoor run of the main kennel will need to be repaired as it cannot be effectively cleaned and disinfected.

3. Repairs are done when necessary

Several areas of loose wire, broken wire or lack of wire to safely contain dogs, as listed under 'shelter structurally sound' need to be repaired. Items stored above or near the dog enclosures must be secured away from within reach of the dogs. The large hole in the concrete of the one run in the outdoor portion of the main kennel needs to be filled in. In the exercise pen outdoors, loose bungees lying around, loose tarps and any other material dogs could ingest or become injured on need to be removed.
