## REMARKS:

The SPCA of Cattaraugus County does show some more improvements made to the kennels and the facility itself. Staff have been educated on proper paperwork to be obtained before releasing a dog to the owners.

Various other improvements include: 12 new kennel doors replacing the old ones, old insulation (edible hazard to the dogs) removed entirely and food moved on to pallets.

Due to the repairs being made, I feel that the kennel should be recognized for their efforts. However, they need to ensure that they can control the temperature and heating come winter. The SPCA reports that they have quotes and money to fix and replace the insulation and heating system for the building. Due to the weather at this time, the temperature of the building is sufficient, but an inspection will be conducted prior to the onset of winter to ensure a proper heating source is in place.

The City of Olean contract is currently being updated and should be in place by next month (per the Mayor of Olean). All other contracts are current, being open-ended.
