> There is not a current contract with the town of Hartsville, The last contract is dated 5/14/13. There is a misunderstanding regarding the person responsible for the disposition of the dogs for each township. This resulted in the town of Hartsville being charged a large sum of money for "boarding" until the dog was humanely euthanized after 3 months in the shelter. This needs to be resolved.

REMARKS:

The shelter is in good condition, although the ventilation could still be improved. It is recommended that a larger exhaust fan be considered for purchase in the near future.

All paperwork is in order except for recording license numbers on the paperwork for three redeemed dogs.

The contract with the town of Hartsville is in place until 2020. It is strongly recommended that the contract be changed so that it is renewed on a yearly basis in order to review the contract and specifically state what responsibilities are assigned to the DCOs in Canisteo and Hartsville. It is recommended that the town of Canisteo be responsible for the disposition of all of the town of Hartsville dogs since there has been a lack of communication between the two towns. This resulted in the town of Hartsville having been given a bill for a daily boarding charge of three months on a dog that was eventually euthanized.
