It is recommended that consideration be given to replacing them with metal doors. The outside of the kennel should be cleaned as well. The weeds should be cut and the debris (old shirt, bags, pieces of plastic) strewn around the kennel should be picked up. Loose pieces of metal were seen in one of the runs also. There is an old bird nest on the top of the wire on one of the outside kennels.
