**REMARKS**:

The redemption of dogs was discussed:

- Dogs seized by Dog Control Officers due to violations of Article 7 or local law can only be redeemed to the owner upon proof of a current dog license AND payment of an impoundment fee. Fees must be collected in the amount required by Section 117.4 of Article 7 or as set by the municipality. Any fees relating to redemption can be addressed in the contract or with guidance from the municipality.

- The shelter can accept unidentified and unlicensed dogs found at large by "Good Samaritans" under Section 373 of Article 26. Since the DCO is not involved in this type of seizure, no impoundment fee or dog license is required upon redemption to the owner. However, these dogs may be considered as seized under Article 7 if the municipality accepts responsibility. Municipal responsibility should be spelled out in the contract. Redemption requirements under Section 117.4 must then be followed when returning the Article 7 seized dogs to their owner.
