One kennel room had a hole approximately 12 inches wide in the wall due to broken tile. Some doors are rusted and damaged along the bottom from exposure to cleaning solutions. A surface board has completely separated from the wall in a non-kennel area.

The presence of odor and humidity in two of the dog kennel rooms indicate a lack of air exchange. See "Remarks".

## **REMARKS:**

- Upon entering Dog Kennel Room "A" there was a noticeable odor of fecal matter. One dog kennel held fresh excrement. There was no discernable movement of air. An air vent had a buildup of dust and dirt on the grating.
- Upon entering Dog Kennel Room "B" the air was hot and moist. There was an unpleasant odor emanating from the drain in the floor. There was no discernable movement of air.

NOTE: Proper ventilation maintains ambient temperatures, prevents accumulation of moisture and decreases odors without causing drafts. Clean fans and air ducts operate more efficiently. It was noted in the inspection dated 9/22/15 that the ventilation system should be checked and cleaned every 3 months and especially before the winter months when doors and windows are closed to natural air movement.

The needed repairs and maintenance do not immediately compromise the health and care of the animals. The shelter is expected to have addressed these issues either by making the repairs or by presenting a plan that will address these issues in a timely fashion. The next inspection of the shelter will be conducted in approximately 60 days.
