REMARKS:

Records must be complete at the time of inspection this often is accomplished by communication between the municipal offices, the contracted shelter and the DCO.

According to Article 7 section 117.7(a) All Transfers to a municipal shelter or Dually incorporated SPCA must be documented on the disposition records including the date of transfer and where it was transferred to.

According to Article 7 section 117.4 Dog Control, municipal shelters and municipalities may not waive Impoundment fees or charge less than the statutory rates for impoundment fees unless a local ordinance has been written. All dogs which are seized/ picked up for Article 7 reasons a disposition report must be filled out and an impoundment fee collected.

All impound fees collected must be recorded somewhere with the disposition reports in order to determine this at the time of inspection. The shelter cannot release an "Article 7" dog unless the owner shows proof of current dog license and proof that the impoundment fee has been paid. According to Article 7 Section 113.4 and 113.5 All records must reflect this information has been verified and be included in the disposition records.

If your municipality chooses to make the fees higher no local ordinance is necessary. Although fee rates should be collected consistently with each towns fee schedule.

These fees/ count against the owner not the dog. Therefore, if an owner redeems his 2 dogs that would be considered a first and a second offense.
