According to Article 7 section 117.4 Dog Control, municipal shelters and municipalities may not waive Impoundment fees or charge less than the statutory rates for impoundment fees unless a local ordinance has been written.

There were 2 dogs redeemed by the same owner both dogs were charged a \$15 impoundment fee. Assuming this was the owners first offense in 12 months' dog #1 would have been your municipalities rate of \$15 (this was ok because it is not less than \$10 for the first offense) Dog #2 is any dog owned by that person was also charged your municipalities rate of \$15 (this was not the proper fee because it was less than the Statutory rate of \$20 for the 2nd offense)

Statutory rates for Impoundment fees are as follows and may not be less than \$10 for the first impoundment, \$20 for the 2nd and first 24 hours, then +\$3 per day or \$30 for 3rd and first 24 hours, then +\$3 per day, unless there is a written local ordinance stating a specific circumstance. If your municipality chooses to make the fees higher no local ordinance is necessary.

These fees count against the owner not the dog. Therefore, if an owner redeems his 2 dogs that would be considered a first and a second offense.

If your municipalities do not want to follow this fee schedule or would like to continue as you have been charging each town may elect write a local ordinance as stated above.
