### A. Standards of Care

1. Shelter is structurally sound

2. Housing area and equipment is sanitized regularly

The Adoptable Dog Room has cobwebs attached to the top bars of some dog runs. DCO Taylor could not recall the last time the room was sanitized top to bottom. The Stray Dog Room has a dog run (closest to laundry room) where fecal matter has accumulated on the floor in a space between the back wall and the back chain link panel. The Feed/dishwasher Room is unorganized and overstocked with bags of food that make this room unable to be sanitized. Litter pans that had been emptied but not yet cleaned and disinfected were stacked in the wash tub.

3. Repairs are done when necessary

The Stray Dog Room has some dog runs that have sharp metal edges along the guillotine door that could cause injury to an animal. Some of the runs have front chain link doors where an animal has pushed the chain link aside creating a space where a dog may get their head trapped in.

## **REMARKS:**

Not all dog runs in the Stray Dog Room are usable due to sharp metal edges and misshapen panels that may cause injury to an animal.

The facility is composed of animal housing areas and a common food prep area that are constructed of non-porous material that allows for disinfection. Some of these areas are used to store porous materials that would absorb liquids used in the sanitation process. There was no recollection of the last time these areas were completely disinfected.

All animals in the facility appeared healthy.
