## **REMARKS:**

Section 117.6 of the NYS Agriculture and Markets Law states that an owner may redeem such dog by payment of the impoundment fee and producing proof that the dog has been licensed. No dog is to be released to its owner until these provisions have been met. A dog is to remain in the custody of the DCO / Shelter Operator if it needs a rabies vaccination which is a requirement for licensure.

Inspector asked that a key to the shelter be maintained at the Wayland Town Office or other Town facility. This would enable access to Shelter by a representative of the Department of Agriculture and Markets and another Town Official if the Matthews were unavailable for an inspection.
