## **REMARKS**:

The shelter manager was not present during the inspection. The door was left open for me so I could do the inspection. There were no dogs in the shelter at the time of the inspection. The fencing was reinforced so no dogs could escape. The soffits were sealed so birds could no longer roost in the building. These were the main concerns at the time of the previous inspection. There were only two items that need to be addressed. One dog door to the outside kennel has been partially chewed leaving wood splinters exposed. The ventilation was not adequate at the time of my visit. There was a distinct "doggie" odor to the kennel. The ventilation fan was not running at the time of my inspection.

The major recommendations from my last visit were addressed. It is important to maintain the shelter so it is structurally sound and safe for the dogs housed there.
