These are the findings of an inspection of your facility on the date(s) indicated above:

#### 1. Shelter is structurally sound

Roof on back side of shelter is leaking. Ceilings in the kennels are warped and moldy from being exposed to excessive water. Electrical hazards were observed on vacant side of kennel. Water was leaking around the light fixtures attached to the ceiling. No

#### 2. Housing area and equipment is sanitized regularly

Back walls of kennels are not adequately sealed to allow for proper cleaning and disinfecting surface area. Disinfectant available is insufficient to effectively disinfect housing area and kennels. There was no active ingredient listed on bleach product provided. Kennel pull out trays were filled with excess fecal material. A blanket covered in feces was left in kennel area on top of a disconnected propane tank 3. Repairs are done when necessary No Chain link on kennel doors and metal bars are rusty. 4. Dogs are handled safely Yes 5. Adequate space is available for all dogs Yes 6. Light is sufficient for observation No Lighting was very dim. Unable to adequately observe kennels for cleanliness without pulling out trays. 7. Ventilation is adequate No Strong ammonia smell was present upon entering the shelter/kennel area 8. Drainage is adequate No Floors were damp in kennel area. There was standing water present on the vacant side of the shelter area. 9. Temperature extremes are avoided No

Heat source did not appear to be working upon arrival for inspection. Heating system was blowing cold air in the kennel. It was 35 degrees F outside on the day of the inspection. The kennel area was very cold upon entering. A thermometer is not present in the housing area.

10. Clean food and water is available and in ample amount No Not all food was stored in covered containers. Observed open bags of food and boxes of biscuits in kennel area. 11.
