## **REMARKS**:

N/A=Facility inspection only on this date as unable to reach Shelter Manager/DCO at time of inspection to obtain and review records. Records will be examined at DCO inspection to be scheduled within next two weeks.

Shelter Manager/DCO's town cell phone & personal cell phone (listed on Town website) were not accepting messages at time of inspection and he did not respond to missed calls placed by inspector. The Town Clerk could not locate any recent records at time of inspection. Record availability will be discussed at next inspection.

The shelter facility inspection found several deficiencies as noted above. In addition, the heater in the pound appeared to be running on high the entire time during inspection and the room was already very warm-laser temperature gun recorded temperatures over 80 degrees in some parts of the room. This may be present an overheating problem if there is no thermostat on the heater or it is malfunctioning and the weather suddenly warms. As no dogs were present in the kennel at the time of inspection and shelter manager was not present to provide further information, this was not noted as a deficiency in this report.
