Municipal responsibility for unlicensed, unidentified dogs seized in violation of Article 7 and local law is to impound at the municipal shelter for the statutory five day redemption period. After that, dog may be transferred to the shelter for adoption or euthanized and documentation is required. Redemption period for unlicensed, unidentified dogs may be reduced by local law or ordinance to no less than three days.

Impound fees paid by owner shall be the property of the municipality to which they are paid.
