This was an unannounced re-inspection of the Canisteo Municipal Shelter. Mr. Howland only gave me the key; he did not accompany me for the inspection. The shelter was in much better condition than at the previous inspection. Only one dog was housed in the kennel. It was not in a kennel that had outdoor access. There was food and water available. The rubber mat that was provided for the dog on which to get up off of the concrete as dirty, but no feces or urine were seen in the kennel. It appears that the outdoor runs are not being used at all right now, even just to let the dogs out for a short time while the shelter is cleaned.
