This shelter is divided into 2 spaces: the "vacant" side and the "main" side. The "vacant" side of the shelter must NOT be used to house dogs for any purpose. This side of the shelter/kennel is under construction and must not be used until all repairs have been completed. There is currently no electricity on this side of the shelter and the roof is not structurally sound.

The "Main" shelter area is the only area that was previously inspected to allow for proper holding of seized dogs.

There were 2 dogs being housed on the "vacant" side upon my inspection.

Recommend installing a thermometer. Thermometer previously installed has broken.
