Regarding "Repairs are done when necessary": Needed repairs to the wallboard and kennel room doors were also noted on the inspections dated 8/31/17, 11/9/17, 3/22/18, 5/21/18, 7/2/18, 8/23/18, 10/24/18 and 12/5/18.

Regarding "Ventilation is adequate": Kennel rooms were inspected in sequential order from Room A to E. Very little or no excrement was present in dog runs in these rooms. The odor in each room became less noticeable with progression through them. Room A had a noticeable urine odor with five dogs there, Room B had some odor with 10 dogs housed in that room, Room C had very little odor with 11 dogs housed, Room D had a damp drain odor that was slightly detectable, and Room E had no detectable odors present with approximately 4 dogs housed there,

The appearance of all areas of the shelter appeared generally clean and in order.
