Some of the municipal contracts specify that ALL seized dogs will be held for only "until midnight of the fifth day". I reviewed redemption periods for identified vs unidentified dogs with shelter staff. Kennel Manager to discuss revision of contract wording to comply with Article 7 with shelter Board of Directors. No dogs were found to have been held fewer days than required at time of inspection.

Shelter is collecting license fees & submitting them, along with completed, signed license application forms to the clerks of the towns where the dogs reside, but does not know whether licenses & tags are actually subsequently issued to the dog owners by the clerks. Shelter has no record of any town license numbers issued for dogs redeemed after 01/01/2011. State dog license numbers are on file for dogs redeemed prior to 01/01/2011. Kennel Manager to discuss with town clerks & shelter board to establish system to verify issuance of town licenses
