Dirt floors are not acceptable. Dirt is organic material and cannot be disinfected properly. Dogs must be housed where adequate sanitiation is achievable. Observed dead rat in bucket of water during inspection.

3. Repairs are done when necessary

Shed structure is in progress.

All kennels were full and there was not additional space if another seizure was to be picked up.

## **REMARKS:**

ACCORDING TO NYCRR PART 77.1 and 77.2 (Standards for the Care of Seized Dogs): "...Shall be properly cared for, sheltered, fed and watered." Shelter facility must have provisions available to avoid temperature extremes for unacclimated, young, sick or aged dogs. Auxiliary ventilation, such as fans, blowers, or air conditioning must be added to keep the animal cool, in temperatures 85 F and up. I recommend a thermometer be installed in the new housing area to monitor temperature. Discussed adding supplemental heat in the garage during the colder months.

According to Article 7 Section 114.1 and 114.2 a current written lease must be on file at the shelter during inspection.
