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REMARKS:

As per NYCRR Part 77.4, as agents of the commissioner, we at any reasonable time enter and inspect municipal shelter or pound or any establishment under contract with a municipality to provide pound or shelter services. Additionally, according to NYCRR Part 78.1, as agents of the commissioner, any records required to be maintained by a municipality pursuant to the provisions of article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law shall be open to inspection. Numerous attempts have been made to contact DCO for inspection. Field supervisor made additional attempts to contact DCO and Town Supervisor. Town Supervisor spoke with field supervisor and understood that inspections need to commence and contact needs to be made with DCO. Following that conversation, additional messages have been left with DCO's phone, and at the Town Hall to notify of inspection.

As per NYCRR Part 77.1 & 77.2, enclosures and equipment need be kept in a clean and sanitized condition to prevent disease transmission and aids in the control of rodents and pests. Food and water bowls need to be sanitized when dirty and before use by another dog. Repairs need to be maintained on a continual basis in to aid in the safe housing of seized dogs. Surfaces need to be non-porous in order to be disinfected. Fresh available food and water must additionally be available for seized dogs.
