REMARKS:

Many of the exterior kennel runs connected to the interior housing are in need of repair or re sealing, but were not in use at the time of inspection.

Please note the following repairs necessary before dogs are to utilize these runs.

Exterior runs on the "entry" side of the building, starting numerically from entry gate to runs - runs 1-5 require concrete cracks to filled and concrete floor resealed; runs 6-9 have "pitting" of the concrete that needs to be filled and resealed; runs 5 requires replacement of gate as cross bar support rusted through with sharp edges (safety concern); runs 9 & 10 have chain link fencing supports rusted and broken in need of replacing. (safety concern). Much of the chain link fencing is rusted and in need of attention.

Exterior kennel runs on the "back" side of the building, starting numerically from the entry gate to runs - kennel 1 has chain link support in need of repair; runs 2,3,4,&7 have rusted cross bar support in gates that require repair or replacement of gate; kennel 9 needs crack in concrete floor filled and resealed; kennel 11 requires concrete erosion of guillotine saddle to be repaired.

Interior "front cage" should have cover over floor drain opening to prevent dog from stepping in it; holes in walls need to be repaired - plaster exposing lathe and insulation behind and concrete holes where previous plumbing came through.
